2) Chichester Hothouse – Open to business in West Sussex

The Business Hothouse is a free business support program that runs until September 2022.

The Business Hothouse is a free business support programme, run by experts, that is funded through the ERDF and HM Government. It's open to any business or individual based in the coast-to-capital area and runs until September 2022.

We offer 12 free hours of expert knowledge support across any these six key areas of business:

- Perfecting Productivity and Going for Growth
- Finding Finance & Funding
- Developing Leaders & Managers
- Invest4 Grant Funding
- Commercialising Innovation
- How to Start a Start-up

Our support is provided through in-person and online workshops, boot camps and 1-2-1 sessions. The best way to find out where and when we're delivering these is to <u>sign-up to our Emailer here</u>, which we broadcast once a fortnight or to check <u>our Facebook Page</u>.

3) National Lottery Funding – Platinum Jubilee - https://platinumjubilee.gov.uk/funding/

Are you seeking funding to support an event or activity you are planning for The Queen's Platinum Jubilee? A range of options are available.

More than £22 million of National Lottery funding is being made <u>available to help communities</u> across the country celebrate the Platinum Jubilee:

- The National Lottery Community Fund's <u>Platinum Jubilee Fund</u> will provide grants of up to £50,000 to 70 impactful community projects across the UK. In addition, grants of up to £10,000 from The National Lottery <u>Awards For All programme</u> will be available for community-led events throughout 2022.
- Arts Council England's <u>Let's Create Jubilee Fund</u> will support voluntary and community organisations in England to develop creative and cultural activities as part of Platinum Jubilee celebrations with grants of up to £10,000.
- The Arts Council has also announced £175,000 to help libraries celebrate. The funding will be distributed by n_Libraries Connected, and will provide £1,000 for each library service
- Throughout the year community organisations will also be able to apply for grants from the Arts Council's <u>National Lottery Project Grants programme</u>, which has been refreshed with new guidance to better support a broader range of ambitious cultural projects.
- The <u>National Lottery Heritage Fund</u> will support communities to take action to help natural green spaces flourish as a legacy of the Platinum Jubilee. Additional funding will create <u>70</u> paid placements for young people from under-served and disadvantaged backgrounds. More details of these funds will be shared in January.
- Sport England's Queen's Platinum Jubilee Activity Fund, which will open at the beginning of 2022, will focus on the role of sport and physical activity in tackling inequalities and building stronger communities. More details of this fund will follow in coming months.

For local authorities there are some funding options for local authorities as part of existing schemes:

- The Government's <u>Welcome Back Fund</u> aims to help boost the look and feel of high streets and seaside towns. If you've signed up, the Welcome Back Fund could help with basic preparation for Platinum Jubilee activities before 31 March 2022.
- The <u>High Streets Strategy</u> is an opportunity to spruce up streets for the festivities. It could be used to promote the Platinum Jubilee, local history or local heroes.

You may also wish to generate your own funds to support specific events to mark this significant milestone in our shared history. And don't forget that community events don't need to cost a lot of money. It's amazing what you can achieve with a little bit of community spirit!

6) Small business grants – Check out your own local council for LEAP funding – Below is the detail from Horsham District Council - but do check your own area for full details.

HORSHAM DISTRICT COUNCIL - LEAP is now open to applications until Monday 28 February 2022. Apply online now.

LEAP grants are a small injection of funding of up to £2,000 aimed at start-ups and small businesses based in the Horsham District, with less than 20 FTE employees. You will need to match fund the grant funding by contributing towards 25% of your total project cost with your own investment.

In order to apply, you must meet the following requirements:

- Registered with Companies House or HMRC
- Less than 20 employees (FTE)
- Located in Horsham District
- 25% match funding
- Must have a fully costed, 3-year business plan

Please note: the LEAP grant cannot go towards project expenditure that was spent prior to the date of application. Applicants who have received 2 or more LEAP grants in the past are also excluded from submitting any further applications.

Eligible project expenditure includes: equipment, building works, e-commerce, etc. but does NOT include salaries, overheads, rent or stock.

Apply for LEAP funding

Applying is easy. All you need to do is fill in our <u>online application form</u> and include the following:

- Details of the project you are applying for and how it will help establish or future-proof your business
- The timescale of the project you are intending to use the funding for
- A breakdown of how you will use the grant, plus your own financial contributions. Use our <u>LEAP Grant project expenditure sheet</u> to do this.
- Your fully costed, 3-year business plan. If you require a business plan template and advice, please visit the Government website. You can also find more useful links on our <u>Start Up</u> <u>Local page</u>.

This round of LEAP funding is open to applications until 28 February 2022. Appraisal panel meetings are held every 4 weeks, therefore applicants are notified of a decision within 4 weeks of submitting their application.

Appraisal panel meetings are currently scheduled to take place on the following dates:

- Friday 4 February 2022
- Friday 4 March 2022
